### **Healing Centre**

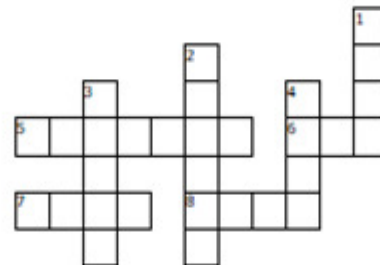
