Training in this policy is mandatory and part of our strategy for educating and reducing risk for all people, our volunteers as well as those whom we serve. *All parishioners who work with children, young people or vulnerable adults are invited to attend training in this policy and the associated procedures.* Priests, religious and parish staff will also attend training.
