The Saint Bernardines Conference of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society has been active for another year. For the 2014 calendar year, through the Grace of God, the St. Bernadine's Regents Park Conference of the Society of St Vincent de Paul provided a total of \$31,631 in direct assistance to people on approximately 405 occasions.

Our area includes Browns Plains, Regents Park, Park Ridge, Hillcrest, Boronia Heights, and Drewvale suburbs. We also had a few cases from Park Ridge South and Greenbank.

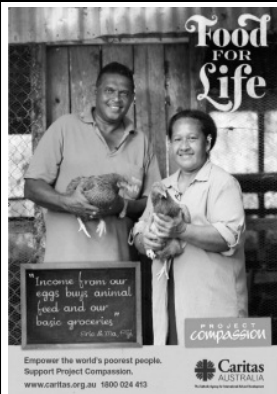
The total expenses of \$31,631 comprised Woolworths Essential Cards (\$29431), Payment of bills and other assistance (\$2024) and purchases used in Christmas hampers (\$176).

Receipts totaled \$34,083, comprising grants from the Gold Coast SVdP Diocese (\$25470), private donations from known sources (\$3229), corporate donations (\$1500 from Motorama), cash box and other donations (\$1861), St. Bernardines School (\$1799 for the Christmas appeal donated by staff), and a client refund for an agreed purpose (\$224).

We can't give an exact figure for Christmas bauble sales, as these were mixed up with poor box and general donations, but we estimate we received approximately \$600 due to this new initiative by Fr. Tony, from both the Regents Park and Park Ridge congregations. We did quite well out of cash donations this year, and we believe the bauble sales were a significant factor. This figure is included in the "cash box and other donations" of \$1860 shown above.

At Christmas, we were able to provide 100 eco-bags due to donations by the parents and students of St. Bernardines School. John Mickel, the former member for Logan, supplied a further 50 hamper bags and between them and your usual helpful giving to the Gifting Tree, we supplied 22 families with gifts and hampers, and another 25 families with hampers only.

On behalf of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society in our parish, I'd like to thank you for your generosity during the year, the school staff and parents for their assistance at Christmas, John Mickel for his gracious donation and delivery time, Linus Power, Alan and John Vigor for assisting with Christmas deliveries, Fr. Tony for his baubles idea, but most of all I'd like to thank our Conference members and their families who do the work, week in, week out.

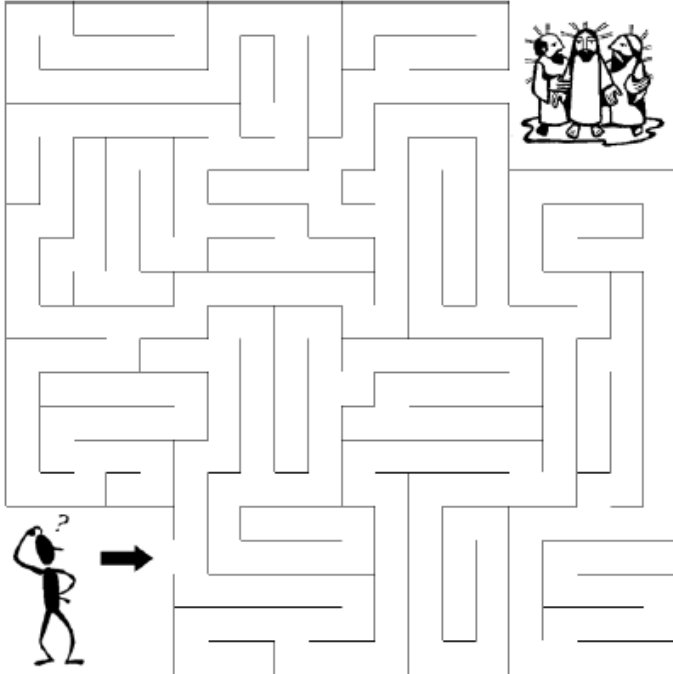

After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. Mark 9:2

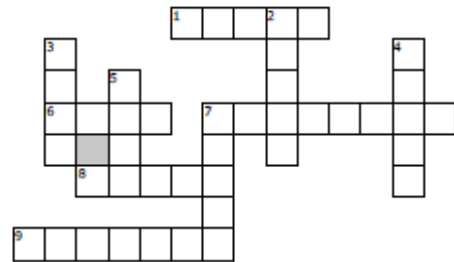
