GOSPEL REFLECTION

Last Sunday we heard Mark's account of the 12 sent out to share in the Saviour's mission. Today we have the aftermath described in vivid detail.

As they rejoin Jesus, they are full of stories as they share the experience of their missionary journeys. We glimpse the openness and hospitality of the band Jesus gathered around him – "there were so many people coming and going that the apostles had no time even to eat". Jesus suggests they cross the water to a "lonely place" where they can "rest for a while". Now he will teach them how to find the interior strength that comes from reflection and contemplation.

The scene Mark describes, as Jesus and his disciples arrive at their destination, is a memorable one. The crowd has heard of their coming and awaits them. Hungry for what Jesus has to give them, they "were like sheep without a shepherd". So he changed his plans and "set himself to teach them at some length."

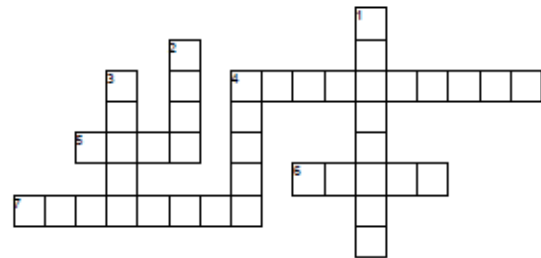

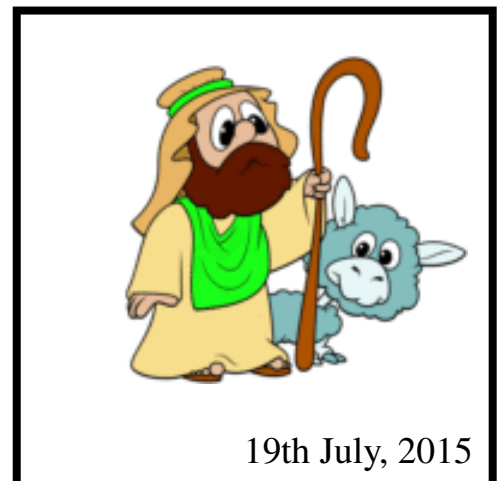
