**GOSPEL REFLECTI**

Can you remember a time when someone or something changed before your eyes and you saw goodness and beauty there that you never saw before, and you were deeply moved? It could be the beauty of nature: a river, a lake or the ocean, a sunrise, a sunset or the stars in a clear night sky. At a particular moment, and completely unexpectedly, as you look at one of these you are deeply touched; you can say to yourself what St Peter said at the Transfiguration: "it is good for me to be here." Or it could be the goodness and beauty of a person that suddenly shines out for you. It may be someone close to you who normally seems so ordinary, yet at a special moment is changed before your eyes and the person's wonderful beauty shines out. Parents may have this experience at the birth of their children or as they see them on First Communion day, all dressed up and glowing with wonder and excitement. At such moments they know that all the sacrifices they make for their children are well worthwhile.
