**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

The overall structure of Luke's gospel is becoming familiar to us. After his ministry in Galilee, Jesus prepares his disciples for what awaits him in Jerusalem. The incident in today's gospel reading from Luke – also emphasised by Mark and Matthew – initiates the formative relationship Jesus now wishes to enter into with his disciples. 'Who do you say I am?' is a very challenging question. Beyond names and family ties, it concerns the commitments and loyalties that shape a person's identity as their life unfolds. It is challenging, because it invites the one addressed to measure themselves against these commitments. What follows in the gospel narrative makes it clear that this is what Jesus intends as he asks his question of his first followers. And he asks the same question of those in every generation. Jesus invites his disciples to identify with his mission for the life of the world, fully aware of all that this mission involves.
