GOSPEL REFLECTION

Jesus does not scorn the Law; he is a faithful observer of the Law himself; but his story illustrates the fact that the Law was only a preparatory education for the fulfilment that is to take place in his own person – as he gathers all the peoples of the world into the one family of his heavenly Father. He fulfils all that the Law looks forward to; bringing the New Commandment that knows no exclusive limits: 'You must love one another just as I have loved you'. The parable challenges us to reflect upon our own attitudes. We all become indignant at the religious antagonisms that show their ugliness in today's world. But what is the quality of our good will to those who are different from us (ethnically, culturally, and socially); are we ready to show that good will in a practical way? As we become more familiar with the Old Testament, we are probably dismayed by the spirit of vindictiveness that is sometimes evident. Today's gospel illustrates the way in which the Saviour leads God's people beyond the half-learned lessons of the Old Testament to a full sharing in the ways of God.
