Regents Park SvDP



This past year has seen a significant increase in the need of help for many families in our community experiencing difficult times.

In the past twelve months our Vincentians helped around 769 families and around 2255 people in total. This represents a 56 per

cent increase in the number of visits – assisting families with food, food vouchers, utilities, rent assistance to prevent homelessness, furniture, cost of essential prescriptions and fuel as well as blankets during winter, clothing and some school uniforms.

We are exceptionally grateful to the students and teachers of St Bernardine's for their amazing fundraising and food raising efforts throughout the year as well as our caring parishioners and our many local sponsors. who have donated money, food and gifts. This year we were also blessed to make connections with the Greenbank Services Club Community Benefit Foundation, which very generously donated more than \$8905 to the installation of our community pantry that has assisted our Vincentians greatly as they rotate food through the pantry to provide for our community.

With the cost of living nearing a 30-year high, we can only expect to see even more need from the most vulnerable in our community. Thank you to all for your continued support as we look forward to providing a hand up to the most vulnerable in our community.


