Ministry Matters NCP (National Council of Priests)

FROM THE As you may be aware, I have been elected on to the

PASTOR'S DESK Executive of the NCP. There are priests from all over Australia on the Executive and so we normally meet each

month on ZOOM. But in February, we are meeting face to face and it is happening in Belmont in Victoria, where the NCP head office is located.

Therefore, I will be away from the Parish from Monday 6th February until Wednesday Evening 8th February.

Sadly, there will be no masses available through those three days here in the Parish. I am sure that St Catherine's Community can still get together and pray on the Tuesday, and for St Bernardine's Community there are Masses available in the neighboring parishes for those who are able to travel.

The NCP is an organization that has its roots in a gathering of Australian priests which took place in Lorne in Victoria, way back in 1971, some 52 years ago, and through all of this time, the NCP executive have guided and directed the way forward not only for the Organization itself but also for the priests of Australia who have benefited from all that the NCP has done throughout its long life. I have been a part of the NCP for some 30 or more years, and now I have been elected to the Executive.

Sadly, the interest in joining the NCP from many of our young priests and many of our overseas priests has waned considerably, and it seems that NCP may be coming to the end of its days in its current format. This will be one of the dominant factors in the unfolding conversations that will take place through our two days together. The issue about where we are going as a body of priests into the future.

The NCP has been a strong support network for priests throughout its 50 years, and it seems to me that there is a great sadness if this resource disappears form the Aussie Church.

The NCP has endeavoured to organize a clergy conference every two years, taking place in one of the Dioceses across Australia. It has been in Perth, around Broome, in Toowoomba, Melbourne, Sydney and Adelaide and even Brisbane has hosted such conference, as well as returning to the place of its birth in Lorne Victoria.

I have attended most of these Conferences, and was also instrumental in the planning and preparation of the Brisbane Conference with the Planning team that had come together. All of these events have been _____

a valuable experience in the life of the Aussie priest.

Where we are going into the future is uncertain, but I do hope and pray that we, as the current Executive, can find a way to maintain this valuable resource for the life of our Church in Australia.

Regents Park Parish Sacrament Program CICCA (Christian Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age)

Reconciliation, Confirmation, Eucharist, Penance

Pastoral Registration is open for children ages 7 years and older to commence the Sacramental journey in 2023 that concludes in 2025.

There are four steps necessary :

- 1. <u>**Register:**</u> contact the Parish office by email at stbernardines@bne.catholic.net.au and register your child who will receive a registration form and Mass card.
- 2. <u>Participation in Liturgy</u>: Regularly attend Saturday or Sunday Mass in one of the 3 churches. This is to help your child become familiar with the liturgy of the Mass and participate as much as possible.
- 3. <u>Invitation:</u> As Fr John and the team get to know your child we invite you to an informal program.
- 4. <u>Enrol/Prepare/Celebrate</u>: Children are formally enrolled in the Sacramental Program and attend family centred activity sessions to prepare for the celebration of Penance, Confirmation and First Communion.
