Ash Wednesday—The Lenten Journey.

FROM THE Wednesday of last week marked the beginning of

PASTOR'S DESK our Lenten Journey. Over the next six weeks of Lent, each of us will have the opportunity to stop, take time out of the busyness ness of our lives, even if only for five minutes a day, and be in the presence of God. Throughout these weeks of Lent there are many opportunities provided for us within the parish communities to find some time to build upon our connection with God.

It may be through the weekday Masses available, or through the 'Light and Presence Prayer' time on Tuesday Evening. It may be through one of the Lenten Prayer sessions available throughout the parish as well.

All of these events enable us to stop and to listen. To endeavour to hear the quiet whispers of God echoing through the busyness of our lives. It is for just six weeks that we are given this season of healing, listening and forgiveness that is our Lenten journey. It is a brief time in the midst of the many weeks and years of our lives when we can choose to stop and listen and immerse ourselves in the power and presence of God.

It may be a special time also when we choose our time of private prayer, to go into that secret place of our lives, that place that is known only to God and you, where we pause and pray in the silence of our hearts, and God will hear our prayer there as well.

Whatever way we choose to focus ourselves through this Lenten season, I hope and pray that this time given to us is so much more than just another six weeks of ordinary time in our lives. Let it be important. Let it be a time and a place for you and God. When that happens, when we find a quiet moment in our lives, even if only briefly, this time spend in the presence of God may change our lives, and that can make all the difference.

So, this Lenten season, as Jesus calls us to prepare for the fast approaching Easter season, give alms certainly, fast in your lives,

whenever you are able and pray. Perhaps it is prayer that can indeed sustain us on the journey that is ahead.

May we share that journey together and uncover the wonder of our God in the ordinary and the everyday events of our lives.


