Ministry Matters The Journey through Lent 23

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK This Lent falls in Year A of the Church's cycle which usually co-incides with the RCIA journey. (Rite of Christian initiation of Adults)

Over these next three weeks we will hear three very different stories from the Gospels. They are stories chosen to highlight the faith journey that is connected to the process of Initiation of the RCIA Candidates. This week, the 3rd Sunday of Lent, we delve into the story of the Samaritan Woman - the woman at the well. Week 4 finds us in the midst of the story of the man born blind, and finally, week 5, we revisit the story of the raising of Lazarus.

Now these stories may seem to so many here in the Church, simply stories of the wonder of Jesus life and ministry, but there is so much more to these particular stories chosen for these weeks of Lent, than we may realise.

The woman at the well, is a story of Baptism, received through the 'Living Water' that Jesus promised. Week 4 and the man born blind, leads us into the idea that our Baptism enables us to move from being blind to seeing the presence of God in the world.

Finally the story of Lazarus is the story of death to life, that is at the very heart of Jesus own life and ministry. Each of these stories are meant to lead the RCIA candidates into their own faith journey.

So, perhaps for us as well. We who are so grounded in faith. Over these next few weeks, these same stories will lead us to Palm Sunday and the Easter events that follow.

We will immerse ourselves in our own RCIA journey as we uncover the secrets of all that these Scripture stories bring to us. Living Water calls us to baptism and perhaps to our own mission and ministry as the woman at the well had herself experienced.

The gift of sight, of seeing with the eyes of faith which the man born blind had received, and finally through the Lazarus story we experience that sense of new life through the call of Jesus to us.

Such are the weeks that are ahead for us as we continue our journey to Jerusalem, as we enter into that moment of the Passion event of Jesus Christ. That sacred moment that will ground us all in faith and life and ministry.

May it be for all of us a journey of discovery. God Bless, Fr John


