

FAITH MATTERS

I have noticed over the last few months at Regents park parish we have lost the value of kneeling at the symbolic moments during the Mass. Obviously, for people with mobility or health issues this is not possible and we understand. But I thought I would give some insight into why we should kneel and encourage our children to do so.

People often ask, "Why do Catholics do so much kneeling?"

About the 7th century, however, Catholic theologians put more emphasis on Christ's divinity and introduced kneeling as the only appropriate posture at those points in the Mass when God is believed to be present.

The Catechism of the church tells us that genuflecting is "a reverence made by bending the knee, especially when entering the pew and also to express adoration of the Blessed Sacrament." Jesus is really, truly, and substantially present in the Eucharist, which is reserved in the tabernacle.

In the bible, the Hebrews, regarded kneeling as a **symbol of strength**; to bend the knee is, therefore, to bend our strength before the living God; an acknowledgment of the fact that all that we are we receive from Him. In important passages of the Old Testament, this gesture appears as an expression of worship.

Saint Paul, writing in his Letter to the **Philippians 2:10**, states, "That in the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those that are in heaven, on earth, and under the earth."

So I encourage as many of you to take the time to kneel for the special moments of adoration. More importantly, the Consecration should be a time where we reflect, kneel or if unable please bow. *God bless you all, Jo*.

Outreach update – Strategic Plan Review 2023

On Saturday 11 February 2023, the Outreach Ministry team spent the morning working with members from across our Parish who form the Parish Ministries, as well as other key leaders of our Parish community, to review and update the Regents Park Parish Strategic Plan 2022-26.

Several members of our Outreach Ministry team cross-volunteer with St Vincent de Paul to deliver the community pantry. During 2022, St Vincent de Paul helped 769 families and around 2255 people in total. This represents a 56 per cent increase in the number of visits on the previous year – assisting families with food, food vouchers, utilities, rent assistance to prevent homelessness, furniture, cost of essential prescriptions and fuel as well as blankets during winter, clothing and school uniforms.

With the cost of living nearing a 30-year high, we can only expect to see even more need from the most vulnerable in our community. Thank you to all for your continued support as we look forward to providing a hand up to those in need.

As part of the review of Strategic Plan it was agreed the following activities would be our primary focus for 2023:

Make the Parish Centre accessible for mobility-impaired members of our community.

- + Finish painting the Parish Centre pergola after it was refurbished in 2022.
- t Engage with more local schools to support the community pantry.
- + Acquire blankets and winter needs for the community pantry.
- + Establish a trial program to build a school visiting program to aged care.

Would you like to share the kindness of a personal connection? Human interaction is very important for seniors who are in a Nursing Home. 
