

ANZAC DAY MASS

On Tuesday 25th April, ANZAC Day, I have scheduled a Mass at 8:00am at Our Lady of the Assumption Church at Park Ridge. All are welcome to come and participate in celebration of this most significant Day in our national calendar.

ACACIA RIDGE AND REGENTS PARK

Well, this is the first weekend where I have been divided between these two parish communities. I will sally forth to Fatima Church for the Mass on Saturday afternoon at 4:30pm. On Sunday Morning, I am endeavouring to preside at the 7:30am Mass at Park Ridge, before driving up the highway in order to get to Acacia Ridge parish for the 9:00am Mass. (I do hope there are no accidents on the highway as there had been last Tuesday and the traffic was banked up all the way to Park Ridge turnoff.) The 9:00m Mass at St Bernardine's Church will be covered by a supply priest for that weekend.

Sunday afternoon, I head back to Acacia Ridge for the 5:00pm Mass. (I do hope the locals go out for dinner afterwards, just like the Jimboomba Community. (I may have to start something at the Acacia Ridge pub?) While I am serving Acacia Ridge parish there will be priests coming to Regents Park parish for the 6:00pm, 9:00am and 5:30 pm that weekend.

Next weekend, 29th & 30th April, I am hoping that I will be back to some semblance of normality as I wander around Regents Park Parish celebrating the local masses for that weekend. But everything is still very much up in the air at this time. I would suggest that you ASSUME that the local masses are on at this stage. I will endeavour to alternate between Acacia Ridge parish and Regents Park parish from one weekend to the next.
