FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

response to the Referendum on the Yes vote planned by the Australian Government to take place later in the year.

I have placed a copy at the door of our Churches for you to see. I hope I have not infringed copyright by so doing. I mention this here, because last week, I attended a clergy gathering addressing this very issue. Two leaders of our First Nations People spoke to us of the importance of the YES vote for the future of First Nations People and their place in our Land Australia. Unfortunately, there was no representation for the 'NO' side of the argument, but I was struck by the plea from the two Indigenous people who did speak, and it seems to me that in voting Yes for First Nations Peoples to be included in Australia's Constitution and by giving them a voice to Parliament when it comes to issues affecting First Nations Peoples can only be a good thing, not only for them but for us as Australian People together.

The Referendum later in the year, is a conscience vote for all Australians, but hopefully the outcome of this referendum will give our Indigenous brothers and sisters a place at the table of decisions.

I cannot believe that the leadership of our significant sporting bodies can be so misguided in their support for a YES vote when the time comes, but the decision is ours. May we choose wisely and well in this important

decision for our Land and its people. God bless, Fr John

Lamps Ablaze: Apostolic Priorities for the Archdiocese of Brisbane

#### **Priority Seven:** Embedding Synodal Governance

We have begun the long and complex process of moving towards a synodal mode of governance in the Church, but the process is far from complete; and there is much to be done to embed synodal governance more securely at every level in the Archdiocese... Synodality implies inclusion, and therefore we will have to keep asking how we might at every level include women in the decisionmaking processes of the Archdiocese. So too synodality requires transparency and accountability, and we will have to keep asking what we need to do make the Archdiocese more transparent and accountable.




#### Pentecost (Christianity)

Pentecost is celebrated fifty days after the Resurrection of Jesus at Easter and ten days after Jesus ascended to heaven.

It commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first Christians which gave them the strength, wisdom and courage to proclaim Jesus.

The scriptural text, The Acts of the Apostles, relates the story of the apostle Peter preaching to a large crowd in Jerusalem for the Jewish Festival of Shavuot. Some three thousand were baptised.

Hence Pentecost is often referred to as the Birthday of the Church.
