Ministry Matters Trinity Sunday.

FROM THE So we gather on this Sunday where we encounter God, who is for us, Father and Son and Holy Spirit.

God the Father is creator, who spoke and it would be. From the very dawn of our creation, God has spoken his Word into our lives and into our world, and it is in that moment of speaking that it is created, whatever the IT may be for our world.

Then the Word spoken would become Jesus Christ, Son of God and saviour, who was with God and who was God, from the very beginning. Sent by the Father to bring salvation to our world.

Finally the Spirit, that Holy Spirit of God, the great Advocate, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified. It was this Holy Spirit of God emanating form the Father who empowered Jesus to enter into the human ministry as Saviour and it was that same Holy spirit who would then be sent to the Disciples to continue the mission that Jesus, the Son had begun. So this is Trinity, God who is Father and Son and Holy spirit. Each with their own part to play in the unfolding drama that is human history.

This weekend then, we enter into the celebration of the Eucharist which is offered for the first time to the young men and women of our community who have been preparing for these events through the past few weeks. They and their family members now step up to receive the Eucharist with us the local community. Through this Body and Blood of Christ our young ones and their families, now enter into this time of Trinity as this presence of God, Father and Son and Holy Spirit, draw them into their own personal encounter with God. This weekend, we celebrate with them, and we welcome them into full communion as members of our Community. But this is just the beginning of their journey of faith. I wonder who they will become as they grow in faith, I wonder what they will do as the disciples of Jesus Christ tomorrow.
