So, like so many of our parishioners, the Finance Team will endeavour to tighten the parish belt and cut down on any unnecessary spending that impacts upon the life of our Church.

Hopefully together, we can face this challenging future together and come out the other side when things begin to get a bit better for our world, our society and for our families. May God be with us through these challenging times.
