# Ministry Matters

Invitation and challenge

Last week and this, we have been issued an invitation, or perhaps it is more of a challenge as Jesus spoke to the crowd that had gathered to hear what he had to say. Jesus told them stories. The Sower and the seed last week, the weeds among the wheat this week, and the so many other stories he shared with them to draw his audience into the power and the wonder of that presence of God that he knew so well.

Here was that moment in the everyday world when the Kingdom and the world would meet and it all took place in the person of Jesus.

He was the link. He was the intermediary where Israel, God's People, and God could meet. It was at that meeting point then that Jesus called his audience to be open to the wonder of God in their lives, and this was where his stories would fit into the scheme of things.

So, Jesus told them his stories. He spoke of the Kingdom of God, perhaps in ways that would resonate with them. They would understand the stories. They would see the possibilities of all that was happening within the stories they had heard, and perhaps it was through this moment of encounter that they would begin to see the possibility that God was truly a part of their lives, even in the suffering and struggle that they may have faced for themselves.

God was present, because they understood the significance of the stories that they had heard. But then it happened. Having told his stories, having invited his audience into the unfolding drama of all that was happening, it was then that Jesus issued his invitation. It was both that invitation and at the same time it would be a challenge, and it was quite simple. *Listen, anyone who has ears!* 

Today, as we sit and listen to the stories Jesus told so long ago, that same invitation is offered to us as well.

Listen! Listen to the stories of God present within our own lives today. It can be easy and it can be difficult. Easy because we do have ears to hear, difficult because we become

hear, difficult because we become distracted by all the noises around us. That is perhaps the challenge for us

That is perhaps the challenge for us today. Find the space. Find the silence where God continues to speak to us, and simply listen. I wonder what we will hear?


