# Ministry Matters

# Annual Catholic Campaign 2023

Thank you to all who contributed to the campaign for 2023. If anyone has envelopes still, please place them on the collection plates this weekend and the parish contribution will be delivered this week to the campaign office.

## On-going parish maintenance costs.

Over the past few weeks, our finance team have been confronted with a number of significant expenses that have had to be paid to maintain the life of our parish.

It all started with tree roots wrapping around drainage pipes flowing out from the parish centre. It needed plumbing work to replace or repair the pipes at a cost of around \$11,000.

The problem trees then had to be removed to prevent further damage, again at a substantial costs to the parish to address the situation. In the past few days more trees on the parish property had to be assessed and found to be creating further problems for our plumbing issues. The latest quote for that work is also around \$11,000.

As much as we hate cutting trees down, it is the only solution to alleviate the draining problems that have impacted upon the parish.

The other associated problem is the container shed sitting in the overflow carpark that we have used for storage throughout these past 30 years or so. It too is sitting on drainage pipes impacting further damage being done to the pipes as well.

The container has to be removed to a place that is clear of any pipes on the parish property. We are in the process of obtaining a quote to re-position the shed somewhere on the property that will not affect further drainage.

What that will cost, we cannot be sure, but all of these costings mentioned above, have to be covered by the parish to maintain the life of our parish centre into the future.

It is a most unfortunate situation whereby the works to be done to address these issues, will cost the parish considerable sums of money, but it has to be done to maintain the parish plant into the future. PARISH MEETINGS Parish Centre
