Ministry Matters

St Francis of Assisi prayed, "Praise be to you my Lord, with all your creatures," well before the Season of Creation began. With this simple but profound prayer, by St Francis, the patron saint of ecology, has encouraged believers of many generations to recognize creation as the fruit of God's eternal Love.

Season of Creation which started on the 1st September till October 4 is a time of grace that the Church, in ecumenical dialogue, offers to humanity to renew its relationship with the Creator and with creation, through celebration, conversion and commitment together.

Individuals and communities are invited and encouraged to participate through prayer, sustainability projects and advocacy.

Prayer: Each week in the parish we will prayer for God's Creation in our Prayers of Intercession

Sustainability: Lead a clean-up project that helps all of creation thrive in and around our parish communities.

Advocacy: Raise your voice for climate justice by participating to save our earth and land from harmful environmental changes.

Taking action: During the Season of Creation is living out our Catholic faith. The church following the teachings of Jesus are to work for the common good, which requires dignifying life in all its forms, caring for the common home, creating peaceful societies, and to achieve what Pope Francis call integral ecology in Laudato Si.
