Ministry Matters

The Month of October is a very busy month in the church. This month was traditionally dedicated to the Holy Rosary of Blessed Virgin Mary as well as the Pope marking October Mission Month. By saying the rosary, we are remembering the mysteries of Christ's life and Our Lady's life. Some of you may have seen your parents and grandparents so often praying the rosary. Sadly, these days children are not being taught about the rosary and how to pray. We primarily pray the rosary to honour Our Lady so during the month of October we should increase our Marian spirituality.




REFLECTION BOOKS
