Ministry Matters

This month of October is World Mission Month, where we support the work of Catholic Mission.

Catholic Mission originated from the Pontifical Mission Society. This year Pope Francis's mission day message is "Hearts of Fire, Feet on the Move" based on the Emmaus story.

In his message Pope Francis reminds us that the missionary journey of all disciples is that upon encountering Jesus, our hearts burn within, our feet are set our on the way.

Each year the Pope announces a need in some of the countries overseas and in Australia. This year the program is based in Venilale which is situated in the mountains of Timor Leste.

Missionaries are so important and part of Catholic Mission Vision – providing healthcare and education in many communities.

The Salesian sisters, who first came to Venilale to support the education of young children, discovered a great need for medical assistance. In 1995 driven by their commitment to God/s Mission and hand in hand with the local community, they created the Maria Auxiliadora Clinic, a place dedicated to healing and health education.

I was blessed to have the opportunity to meet with Sr Carolina last week. Her story was incredible. In providing people with physical and psychological care, the clinic takes a holistic approach by sharing healthy lifestyle skills and habits. They spend time explaining to people things. Sr Carolina said," In this way the people feel important and supported." While important progress many challenges remain in keeping the Venilale Clinic running. Doctors are difficult to find and retain and the cost in maintaining the clinic continues to rise. Unfortunately due to damage from unrest the clinic was affected and now needs resources, and buildings maintained for future sustainable work.

The support of Catholic Missions friends and supporters remain an important factor in carrying this life-giving work.




REFLECTION BOOKS


