Once again, this weekend, we pray for peace. Peace throughout our world where there is conflict and division among people, but we pray also for peace within our own society, and within our own communities whomsoever we may be. Be it Israel, be it Islam, or be it Christian, We are all a part of the Kingdom of God, and God is so very much a part of our lives as well. May we find the peace and harmony that can unite us as Australian people no matter the name we have for our God. Peace and harmony always begins with us. Now is the time for us to find that common ground.

We are One but we are Many and from all the Lands on earth we come. We share a dream and sing with one voice. I AM, YOU ARE, WE ARE AUSTRALIAN.


