On this Second Sunday of Advent, we move from that call to be ever vigilant as the Gospel had reminded us on that First Sunday of Advent, to stay awake—be on your guard. This is still very much relevant for us as our journey through the ADVENT Season continues to unfold. But now we move to the next level of formation as we are called now to 'Prepare the Way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Once again, this call for preparation is so significant within our lives. No matter what we endeavouring to establish within our lives, preparation for the event is just so important.

The same is true for the journey to Christmas. No doubt much is being organised and planned for the big day when we gather as family and friends. Food and drink is purchased. Decorations are hung around the house, all in readiness for the arrival of our guests.

The same is necessary for the arrival of the Christ child into our lives at Christmas. Prepare the way of the Lord, we are told. Get ready for what is about to take place once again through the Christmas story.

It may be that we are all too used to getting ready for the Christmas celebrations, so much so, that we know where everything is, and we know what to get to be prepared for Christmas.

But it may be a bit of a challenge for us to focus our lives of faith in getting ready for the moment of encounter with God through the Christmas event that will unfold in the weeks ahead. Somehow, it is important for us to prepare ourselves for that encounter. That can only happen when we stop, take some time our of the busy-ness of our lives and find that sacred space, that sacred moment when we can indeed prepare the Way of the Lord for ourselves. Does anyone have a huge box at home about the size of a fridge. We need it for the children's pageant. Please contact parish office or Jo if you can help.






