Into the Valley of Death

One focus during Lent is to reflect on our own death and to see our way through it. We all must die, as much as we do not like the fact. We try to hide it or deny it. Yet we cannot in fact escape it. Jesus came into the world, not



so much to do away with death (not immediately) but to teach us how to die by his example and then to assure us that death does not say the last word about life. When we walk into the valley of death we do not walk alone. Jesus is with us because He's been there before and knows what it is like. Moreover, he promises us that just as he rose from the dead so will we. We will all be young again. We will all laugh again.

Once upon a time there was a young grandmother who totally adored her oldest grandson (like most grandmothers do). He was a good young man too. Handsome, friendly, courteous, more mature than you could reasonably expect any teenager to be. He was also an excellent athlete and was to be valedictorian of his class. Then, just a week before graduation, another teenager (completely drunk) plunged into the car in which the young man was arriving home from a baseball game. He died three hours later in the hospital. Everyone in the family was devastated, as you can well imagine. The grandmother was furious. "Why do such terrible things happen?" she demanded. "Why did it have to happen to my grandson? What kind of God would permit this to happen to me? He must be a cruel and vicious God. Why should I believe in him? I don't believe in him. My grandson was so young; he had the rest of his life ahead of him. It's all right for 'very old ones' to die, but not for someone who had a right to a long and happy life. I don't believe in heaven. I don't believe in anything."

She carried on like this for months, years, making the tragedy even harder for her family. She stopped going to Church and refused to talk to the priest who visited her house to talk to her. "I just hate God," she insisted. Then one night, maybe she was dreaming, maybe she was half-awake, her grandson, in his baseball uniform, came to visit her. "Cool it, Grams." he told her. "I'm happy. Life is much better where I am. You're not acting like my grams any longer. We all must die sometime, young, or old, but here we're all young and life is peaceful." So, the grandmother began to let go of her grief and rage. Do you find yourself in some similar situation, please let go. In Christ Jesus, life has no end, but is being transformed. Think about this!

SVDP REPORT

In January:

Brown's Plains St Bernardine's Conference had 102 contacts and assisted 300 people including 145 children at a total cost of \$18,623.43. St Catherine's Jimboomba Conference completed 25 visits, assisting 93 people including 50 children under 17 years at a total cost of \$4,456.21.

In February:

Brown's Plains St Bernardine's Conference had 78 contacts and assisted 222 people including 112 children at a total cost of \$10.843.

St Catherine's Jimboomba Conference completed 28 visits, assisting 84 people including 47 children under 17 years at a total cost of \$3,695.01.
