

On behalf of our parish staff and volunteers, I wish you all a Happy Glorious Easter. The resurrection of Christ is the central truth of our faith. It is the solemn seal of Christ's divinity and the truth of his gospel. It is the victory of life over



death, of hope over despair. It is the promise and pledge of our own resurrection. It is God's definitive "Yes" to his Son, God's definitive "Yes" to the whole of creation.

The mystery of the Pasch (Easter) is new and old, eternal, and transient, corruptible, and incorruptible, mortal and immortal. "It is old according to the law, but new according to the Word. It is transient in its prototype, but eternal in grace. It is corruptible in the immolation of the sheep, but incorruptible in the life of the Lord. It is mortal because of his burial in the earth, but immortal because of his resurrection from the dead".

Therefore, Easter is not simply one feast among others, but the "Feast of feasts," the "Solemnity of solemnities," just as the Eucharist is the "Sacrament of sacraments". The resurrection of our Lord tells us that after darkness comes light; after the heartbreak, the daybreak; after the struggle, the victory. Every day the sun goes down in the evening, but the next day it rises again. In every cold climate, nature lies for many months under the spell of winter. But the spring comes once again, and the birds begin to sing, and nature puts forth its garment of greenery and flowers appear in the land.

In the Passion story, the man who was caught by the enemies of Jesus but ran away naked in the dark; leaving his loincloth in their hands, stands for the baptised Christians who runs away at the moment of truth and still doubt the power of the risen Lord. The man whom the women saw in the tomb of Christ stands for all of us symbolically, who have now recovered our faith and standing at the very 'weird' and 'frightening' tomb of Christ to announce to the whole world: **"He is risen".** Let us go therefore, to announce the resurrection to the world and allow ourselves to be 'resurrection par excellence'. Rejoice Christ is risen. Happy Easter and Grace-filled celebrations.
